### **CURRICULUM VITAE**



My name is Diego Bertolotti, I was born in Parma on Tuesday 13<sup>th</sup> April 1993. I have always been passionate about cinema, literature, sport and science, I attended Gianni Rodari Elementary School (1999-2004), Salvo D`Acquisto Middle School (2004-2007) and Brocca Department of Guglielmo Marconi High School (2007-2012); these three institutes are located in Parma.

In May 2007, I got second place in my school in the Aido Provincial School Contest, by writing an essay on organ donation.

In Summer 2009, I was one of the winners in a literature contest on the theme of work, organized by Casa della Giovane, located in the centre of Parma.

In Summer 2009, I deposited in SIAE my first work of mathematics, called “Studio sulle difference fra numeri primi”

(Study on differences between prime numbers).

In March 2011, I became the city champion in Mathematics Olympiads. From the beginning of 2009 to June 2012, I was a member of the Mathematics Team of my school, competing as the captain during my last two years. Around the end of school year 2010/2011, I was admitted at the orientation course organized by Scuola Normale Superiore in Pisa, attending the event itself from 25<sup>th</sup> July to 1<sup>st</sup> June. From July to October of the same year, I spent three months as an exchange student in Perth, Australia, going to Trinity College. I got my Diploma in 2012 with 100 out of 100.

From September 2012 to July 2016, I studied Mathematics at university in Parma, stopping my career five exams before my Bachelor`s Degree.

From April 2015 to June 2016, I attended three courses at Dubbing School in Brescia, under the direction of Luca Gatta.

From November 2015 to June 2016 I attended Dubbing Academy in Milan, under the direction of Christian Iansante (Italian official voice of Bradley Cooper) and Roberto Pedicini (Italian official voice of Kevin Spacey).

In July 2016, I attended a dubbing stage at Dubbing School in Brescia, under the direction of Davide Perino (Italian official voice of Elijah Jordan Wood and Jesse Adam Eisenberg).

I am the official voice (in Italian and English) of Barboj sightseeing tour, located in Rivalta, fraction of Lesignano de` Bagni, in the province of Parma, Italy. The site belongs to Tuscan-Emilian Appennine, which is a MaB area, acknowledged by Unesco.

I have always lived in my city, where I currently dwell, despite travelling a lot. I have visited France, Switzerland, Austria, Poland, Czech Republic and above all Australia. In the course of my life I practised swimming, handball — on an agonistic level, I was for two years the second goalkeeper in Emilia-Romagna —, martial arts and athletics (on an agonistic level).

I can fluently speak Italian and English, on an intermediate level French and German. I can modestly program in languages Pascal and C++. In my free time, I love running and listening to music; I also deal with reading, writing, screenwriting, acting, cinematography and linguistics.

Currently (January 2017):

- I am actor, screenwriter and translator for Collateral Pictures, under the direction of Federico Meneghini;
- I collaborate with Francesco Giuffrida;
- I collaborate with Giuseppe Nardelli for the organization of the game QuizzaMi in some pubs in Parma and surroundings;
- I am working (from August 2016) on a horror movie and (from May 2016) on a dramatic short movie, of which I am screenwriter and organizer.
